The Last Gospel, The First Resurrection and Wrath

- The end of the sixth trumpet and sixth year
 - Rev. 6:12-7:17 detailed the events of the end of the sixth year of the seventieth week
 - 144,000 of Israel sealed
 - Then a scene of the all who are resurrected in heaven
 - Rev. 8:1-11:19 detailed the seven trumpet judgments
 - The seventh trumpet (Woe three)
 - The resurrected in heaven give thanks to God and Jesus (11:15-17)
 - Those who remained are enraged because of God's wrath on them (11:18-19)

The Last Gospel, The First Resurrection and Wrath

- Rev. 14:1-11 describes the last moments before the seventh trumpet sounds:
 - The sealed 144,000 of Israel (14:1-5)
 - The last gospel is preached to all the earth (14:6-7)
 - The announcement that Babylon the great has fallen (14:8)
 - The warning of God's wrath to all who worship the Beast (14:9-11)

Harvest of the Saints

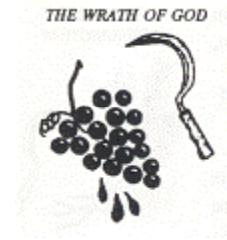
“The First Resurrection”



- Rev. 14:12-16 speaks of the perseverance of the saints
 - Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord (14:12-13)
 - The appearance of the Son of Man on a white cloud
 - Harvest sickle in his hand (14:14)
 - Rev. 14:14-20; Resurrection view #4 Focus is on the Son of Man harvesting the wheat (saints)

Harvest of the Unsaved

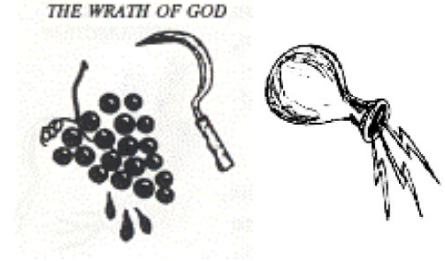
“The Wrath”



- Rev. 14:17-20 speaks of the grapes of wrath
 - The great winepress of the unsaved

Harvest of the Unsaved

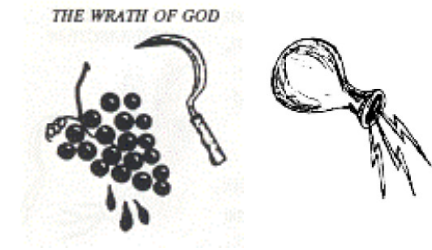
“The Wrath”



- Rev. 15:1-16:1 describes the moments before the wrath is poured out
 - Seven angels with seven plagues (15:1)
 - Another scene in heaven of the resurrected indicating they are taken out of harms way (15:2-4)
 - The seven angels prepare to deliver the wrath (15:5-16:1)

Harvest of the Unsaved

“The Wrath”



- Rev. 16:2-21 describes God’s wrath in detail



- Bowl one—judgment on the earth

- evil sores on the unsaved



- Bowl two—judgment on the sea

- The sea became blood and sea life died



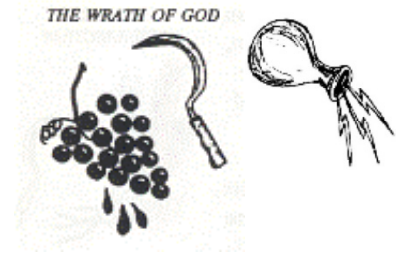
- Bowl three—judgment on fresh water

- Fresh water becomes blood

- The unsaved shed the blood of the saints and are given blood to drink

Harvest of the Unsaved

“The Wrath”



- Bowl four—judgment of the sun
 - The sun becomes scorching hot and burns the unsaved



- Bowl five—judgment on the throne of the Beast
 - Kingdom becomes dark
 - Excruciating pain on all who follow the Beast



- Bowl six—demons go out to gather the kings of the world to make war with God



- Bowl seven--Armageddon
